Sometimes before you are going to appear on a radio talk show or at a lecture, you might be asked to provide in advance a list of questions for the interviewer from basic to more advanced. The host could be a little unsure of themselves about LBL and this list also helps you control the pace of the show. You want the show to contain meaningful questions, especially if the host has not read our books and knows little about our subject. Then too, providing a list of questions helps you prepare for the show. At the time I wrote these 18 questions in the 1990s most people knew little or nothing about LBL and Journey of Souls had only recently hit the market.

1. How did you first learn about what happens to people after death and why did you write the book, Journey of Souls?
2. Is hypnosis a valid means of gaining spiritual information?
3. Explain what happens to people at the moment of death? How do they feel and what are their first reactions?
4. What happens next to the soul? Where do they go right after death and who do they see?
5. Who are spirit guides? Are they guardian angels?
6. Describe the meaning and importance behind the orientation sessions with our guides that you wrote about in the book.
7. Is everyone going to what we think of as heaven or do bad people go to the place we call hell?
8. Don't we go before some kind of court of judgement or tribunal to answer for our lives so we can be punished?
9. Do all souls have a special spiritual place where they go?
10. What is the difference between a primary and secondary group of souls in the spirit world ?
11. Do we see our loved ones and friends that we knew on earth? What do souls do in these groups?
12. Are some souls more advanced than others? What do they do that is different from the rest of us?
13. What do souls do in the spirit world beside studying lessons of past mistakes? Is it all work and no play?
14. Are all souls eventually going to be doing the same thing after they stop incarnating? Do your subjects see God?
15. Do our dreams bring messages from the one's we loved who died? Do they show former lives and our life in between?
16. You say in your book that souls choose their next body and life based on past karma, describe this process.
17. How will we find and recognize our soulmates in future?
18. Explain about returning to our next life on earth and when souls join with their new bodies?
