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Subject: Radio Shows and the subject of books

Dear Group:

For the last 18 years I have done hundreds of radio shows but this is going to change. Recently, the host of a radio show on the east coast contacted Llewellyn and asked if I could do his show with the focus on how is TNI helping other people and to what degree is our organization making a difference in the lives of the general public. I realized that my time on radio shows is drawing to a close because this theme should really be addressed by one of our active board members, and not by an elderly person in retirement. I contacted both Bryn and Paul but since Bryn was out of town teaching I focused on Paul. I was concerned at the timing because Paul has a lot on his mind with the devastation of houses around his New Jersey home from Hurricane Sandy. However, it turns out that in my talk with the host of this show Paul will not be given a time slot until January. This works out much better for Paul in light of his current circumstances.

I wanted to post each of you who might in future be doing radio shows. Always, during the radio shows I promoted our books at least once to the host of the show. They are very accommodating because they know publicity is important to their guests and, after all, the managers of the station have a guest for free so appearances serve them well. If the show has listeners calling in the chances are great that you can promote our books to them. Usually, radio shows can be done at home which is why I lasted so long.

I thought that each of you might like a short statement that I use for each of our books. In doing a radio show it sometimes helps to have notes on your desk about various spiritual aspects of what we do in order to stay on track with what you wish to accomplish. Plugging TNI is of prime concern but usually this evolves into questions about books. So, what I have written below may help you on the show:

A. Journey of Souls (1994). For interested newcomers to our field about the afterlife it is recommended you start with this book. Dr. Newton began his discoveries into the afterlife in 1968 but he spent many years in research with thousands of cases before this book was published in 1994. The book reads like a travel log taking the reader from the moment of death in a past life into the spirit world and then documenting what happens to them as they pass through the gateway and join their spirit guide. This includes emotional meetings with friends and relatives who have preceded the person who has just passed on into the afterlife. The book ends with how we chose our next body and what it is like to return to earth in another life.

B. Destiny of Souls (2000). Like Journey of Souls this follow up book is

documented by case studies. It is far more detailed in scope than the first book because readers wanted to know more about how departed souls reach back to try and contact loved ones still living. The book also gives detailed descriptions about how spirit guides help us, as well as soul group systems that involve what we on earth might call classrooms, libraries, community centers and appearances with higher spiritual beings called Elders or Master teachers.

- C. **Life Between Lives Hypnotherapy (2004).** This book is tightly focused on two primary purposes. Firstly, it is essentially a textbook for new hypnosis practitioners in the art of conducting life between lives therapy. Secondly, this book was designed to provide information to people who might be considering having a life between lives hypnosis session themselves. It gives the general public greater understanding of the process necessary to reach their deep soul mind in the unconscious.
- D. **Memories of the Afterlife (2009).** While the first three books cover about 100 actual cases conducted by Dr. Newton this book is different because it contains 32 life between life cases by other practitioners who are members of the Newton Institute. Dr. Newton was the chief editor and gives footnotes after each case to help the reader. This book provides the major goal of our spiritual movement. Fostering personal spiritual transformation. First, the cases here give validity to our other works by replication of earlier findings. There is a great consistency of ordinary people reporting their experiences into the afterlife. The second major goal of this work was to demonstrate the long term benefits of uncovering the deep seated memories of people recalling their experiences after death on earth.

I hope the above condensation of our four books will help you on radio shows where time constraints is always an issue. Usually, a radio host is pleased to know that you will briefly cover who we are, why are we here, where are we going as well as our purpose on earth in a current reincarnation. They also like knowing about our website. In the past, when I was asked by radio show managers what my central theme would be on their show I would say: "To help dispel the fear of death by showing that each person has an immortal identity and a purpose in life."

Hopefully, I'm not being too presumptive by passing the above on to all of you.
