Dear Michael,

For a while I've been promising some Quantum ramblings and I've reached a point in my theorising where I need a sounding board. Melina has proved to be a wonderful co-conspirator in all this and regularly extends or reconnects some wandering thoughts for me. Ultimately these pieces will fall into my next book, which is gradually taking shape.

Here are a few thoughts in chunks which I'd be grateful if you had some time to offer anything that comes to mind.

I've been studying Greene, Talbot, and Wolf as you suggested. I've been tracking Bruce Lipton and Greg Braden, Lynne Taggart and worked through a fair bit of the Quantum history and evolution towards unified (String) theory. I've been back through your Cosmology postings in a few places and gone back into DOS to various references.

1. I came across the work of Burt Goldman (Quantum Jumping). I really feel his theories are light and that he works with pretty much creative visualisation in order to put in place a scenario that becomes a self-fulfilling prophecy, merely from intention. I couldn't see how this could create an alternate reality, as there is no split in the timeline from some form of Quantum Event (see 2.). I seem to remember you saying something along these lines somewhere but I can't find it. Would like to here your thoughts on his work if you have heard of him.

2. I'm working on a theory that Alternate Realities are created by an event at the Quantum Level. I feel that whilst we set up lifetimes in the Life Selection Room, we merely choose the scaffolding of that life. Free will then builds the texture and challenge of that lifetime. In a nutshell, I'm toying with the idea that the invoking of free will energy as a point of choice, causes the Quantum Event and we move into "non-locality". i.e. We create two sets of particles – two choices...a split in the time line and the creation of the Alternate reality. Both paths continue, the A choice and B choice. This comes about due to the energy of free will affecting the particles as well as the "observer effect" – the act of not merely participating as per the old "double slit experiment" that has been documented so often, but creation

itself. In short the "creator effect".

3. So then I ask myself, given there are different types of particles is the soul energy and the human body made of different types? We know from QM that different types of particles are being discovered all the time. Given 2. above, does that mean that the soul energy has the power to create the body in the alternate reality. I have no theory here...

4. What happens when we get back to the spiritual realm? I am assuming that all the realities become one as the separate timelines no longer exist. We are outside of space and time, and we know that souls can split their energy easily enough and bring it back together. I wonder if this is why we can replay any possible scenario as ways to learn once we return "home" to spirit?

More broadly...

5. String theory. I have always felt that we are made up of tiny shards of pure consciousness at the core of our beings. I wonder if these tiny strings they speak of, merely just mathematically validate this idea?

6. What do you see as the difference between an alternate reality and a parallel universe? I'm leaning towards alternate realities being splits in a particular timeline (Incarnation), whilst parallel universes would include parallel lives (formerly known as past lives), as well as their alternate realities from those other incarnations. We'd have to also throw in the multiverse theory from parallel big bangs as well ?

Anything offered would be greatly received, this is starting to make my head hurt.
